s breezes cool, the end of our ministry year in CEF comes to completion. The year finishes with the high point of Christian Youth in Action Training Camp (CYIA) and 5-Day Club®. Three teens volunteered to attend the training camp and lead a 5-Day Club. A fourth teen was able to volunteer at the club as well. At the end of

summer vacation, Mrs. Ott offered her home in which we could have our 5-Day Club. Of the twelve children we



welcomed to club, about half were from Mrs. Ott's church and half were from the neighbors. The teens successfully held their first 5-Day Club! In the midst of fun and getting to know each other, the gospel of Jesus Christ was clearly shared, Bible lessons taught, scripture verses memorized, and energetic songs voiced. At the end of the week, all were sad to say farewell to each other — some for a week, and others perhaps for a year!

Our year ended up with a Good News Club® in four schools, a one-day Vacation Bible

School, and a 5-Day Club as our formal outreaches. The 25 people in our ministry teams shared with 76 children and 19 of the children prayed to receive the Lord Jesus as their Savior. We rejoice together with you as your prayers and support enable all of

this to occur. Most of these children were discipled weekly in their Good News Clubs. Good News Club season is upon us again. Teams need additional members and training for new and returning volunteers is upcoming. There are also new schools that it appears God is moving towards (if interest from individuals is any indication).
